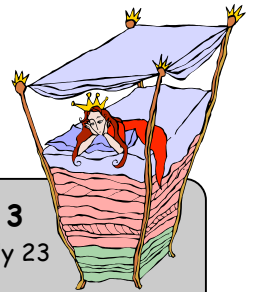
**Schedule:** Mondays - Fridays 9:00 A.M. - 4:00 P.M.

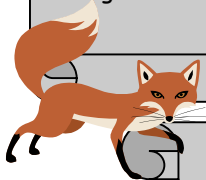
### Session 1

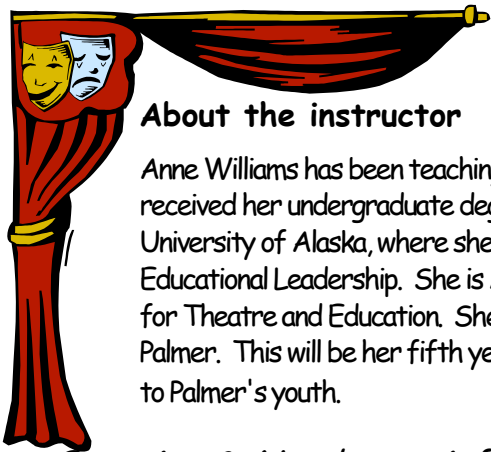
